

COLONOSCOPY COURSE FOR BEGINNERS

“Hands-on” on endoscopic simulators



Who should apply: SpR, CT1 and CT2 interested in a career in Gastroenterology and/or GI surgery

Course objective: learn basic skills necessary to perform colonoscopy

Course details: this curriculum covers:

- Psychomotor skills (hand-eye coordination tasks)
- Colonoscopy
- Presentations on general tips and tricks, torque steering, polypectomy techniques, complications, JAG criteria for certification and endoscopic instruments.

After the course, participants can also choose to get a 60 day pass which gives them free access to the simulators to practice, in their own time, till they are able to meet requested criteria. A certificate will be awarded on completion of the course.
